House Republicans to push tax cut, preschool

House Speaker Brian Bosma, R-Indianapolis, presented an agenda focusing on workforce development – which also included a new focus on college internships, increased funding for roads and highways and the repeal of “burdensome regulations.” Bosma said House Republicans also want to boost highway funding by using part of the \$400 million that was set aside for future projects in the two-year budget passed in 2013. Pence has proposed something similar, but Senate Appropriations Chairman Luke Kenley, R-Noblesville, is skeptical. “We put in last session that we would not spend the \$400 million in this budget cycle because we had already given an extra \$100 million to local governments and given INDOT an extra \$250 million, and we thought we would want to save it for special big projects,” Kenley said. “We’ll need to look over the proposal and if it makes sense.”
