Porter County doubles paving budget

VALPARAISO — County government was able to secure such a good price on paving materials this year that it is doubling the amount it plans to spend. The Porter County Board of Commissioners agreed Tuesday to spend \$2 million on paving this year. The deal was made possible by lower petroleum prices, said Commissioner Jeff Good, R-Center. "We're just trying to take advantage of market conditions," he said. County government is paying for paving out of the proceeds it received from the lease of the Indiana Toll Road, Good said.
